Winter Grounds Maintenance

Driveway Snow Removal

- 1. The driveways, fire hydrants, irrigation boxes, electrical boxes, gas meters, and all other obstructions will be marked with stakes for guidance and safety.
- 2. Snowfall accumulation must reach at least 1.5 inches for driveway snow removal to occur.
- 3. The driveways will initially be "opened-up" to allow access prior to 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. when continuous snow fall accumulations reach 4 inches.
- 4. Driveways will be thoroughly cleaned up within 8 hours of cessation for snow depths of 1.5 inches to 8 inches and within 12 hours of cessation for snow depths exceeding 8 inches. Cessation of snow is defined by the end of precipitation for a given snow event that meets or exceeds the trigger depth of 1.5 inches in the city of Woodbury.
- 5. A snowfall lasting 24 hours or more with an accumulation of at least 1.5 inches will be cleared to allow access.
- 6. Driveways that become closed by the city plows will be opened near the street.
- 7. Two driveway drift plowings will be provided each snow removal season.
- 8. A-1 Maintenance, Inc' is not responsible for slipping and falling on the Heritage Glen Townhome Homeowners, Association property.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

- 1. Sidewalks will be-marked with flags and/or stakes for guidance and to insure safety (excluding stairs).
- 2. Snowfall accumulations must reach at least 1.5 inches for sidewalk snow removal to occur.
- 3. Sidewalks will be cleared within 8 hours of cessation for snow depths of 1.5 inches to 8 inches, and within 12 hours of cessation for snow depths exceeding 8 inches. Cessation of snow is defined by the end of precipitation for a given snow event that meets or exceeds the trigger depth of 1.5 inches in the city of Woodbury.
- 4. A snowfall lasting 24 hours or more with an accumulation of at least 1.5 inches will be cleared for access.
- 5. Snow accumulations will be cleared around fire hydrants (3 feet in radius), around, on top, and in front of mailboxes for easy access.
- 6. Detailing will be done in front of doors and doorways.
- 7. A-I Maintenance, Inc. is not responsible for damage to any electrical cords buried under the snow on the sidewalks.
- 8. Sidewalk snow removal will be delayed if wind chill temperatures reach 25degrees below zero until safer conditions are present.
- 9. A-1 Maintenance' Inc' is not responsible for slipping and falling on the Heritage Glen Townhome Homeowners, Association property.
