LAWN CONCERNS

Personal Touch, our management company, was notified by Land Maintenance that a dog chain was left on a homeowner's lawn and caused damage to their equipment. If a claim were to be filed, the homeowner's insurance would be involved. Insurance carried by Heritage Glen does not cover this type of situation.

Grassy areas should be kept free of items at all times. Tuesday is our normal lawn mowing day.

Lawn damage caused by dogs and by parking along the edges of driveways is the responsibility of each homeowner. If the damage is not

repaired you will be billed for the repair cost.

DISHWASHER RECALL

On May 16, General Electric issued a recall on certain dishwashers manufactured between 1997 December 2001. This period includes the time many of us moved into our Heritage Glen homes, and took advantage of Orrin Thompson's "deal" regarding GE appliances. Please check www.GEappliances.com/recall or phone (877) 607-6395 to see if your dishwasher is affected. If so, it will be fixed free of charge or you will be offered a rebate toward certain new models.

AIR EXCHANGER RECALL

Venmar Air Exchangers installed when our homes were being built may be subject to recall as well. You are instructed to turn them off and unplug them until it is determined if yours is affected. Locate your model and serial numbers, then call Venmar at (866) 441-4645 or access their website at www.venmar.ca for further instructions/information.

DUES INCREASE

Personal Touch has notified all homeowners that effective July 1^{st} , monthly association dues will increase to \$86.00 due to escalating costs of grounds maintenance and water.

DRIVEWAY REPAIRS?

Several homeowners have noted that their driveways require more extensive work than simply sealcoating. The asphalt near the concrete apron of the garage is buckling or sinking, and this problem must be addressed with contracted work that could be expensive.

If a group of homeowners join together to hire a contractor, perhomeowner project quoted prices will be reduced. Rob Blocker will research contractors for this work. He is gathering a list of other Heritage Glen homeowners who would like to realize savings on this repair.

LIVING "GREEN"

Make changes in your life to conserve energy and resources. We'll offer a few more hints in each succeeding newsletter.

#1 - Get the most out of your dishwasher - run it only when it's full. Use the air dry option or prop the door open after the final rinse cycle to dry your dishes.

#2 - Wash only full loads of clothes in cold or cool water instead of hot. They'll still get clean!

#3 - Change your light bulbs to compact fluorescent bulbs which use a quarter of the power and put out a quarter of the heat. They pay for themselves by lasting up to 10 times as long as incandescent bulbs and are just as bright. To save even more on lighting, install dimmer switches and use timers
